

FENCEATHON IS COMING!

Dear Fencers & Parents,

The Chesapeake Fencing Club will present Fence-A-Thon 12, our annual all-night fencing marathon, on Friday and Saturday, October 21 & 22 at Liberty Christian School in Owings Mills. Check-in & registration will be held 7-8 p.m. on Friday, October 21. Fencing will start at 9 p.m. and continue all night long until 6 a.m. Saturday morning for those who go the distance.

Registration packets will be available at the club and on-line at www.fenceathon.com. Pre-register by October 14th and receive a free commemorative tee-shirt with logo created by Crowlf Design. Checks are payable to "Chesapeake Fencing Club". Registration fee is \$35.

There will be trophies given for most bouts fenced and for the most bouts fenced by a Y-14 fencer. We are again expecting the St. Mary's College fencing team, plus Larry Tom from MASHS has been invited to present a demonstration of historical fencing at 12 midnight.

Fencers under the age of 11 should be accompanied by an adult, and should plan on staying until approximately 12 midnight. Fencers over age 10 who will be staying all night should bring a sleeping bag, just in case they start to feel sleepy!

This year, a portion of the proceeds from Fence-A-Thon 12 will once again benefit the Sisters Academy of Baltimore (www.sistersacademy.org). We need our fencers to line up sponsors (friends, family, co-workers, in-laws, outlaws) to sponsor them -- .50, \$1, \$5 per bout, or a lump sum. Please remind donors that, while CFC is a non-profit organization, donations aren't tax-deductible. We are also looking for donations of door prizes, food & drink and for volunteers to help with set-up between 5:00 and 8:00 p.m. Friday and to help with break-down between 6:00 and 9:00 am Saturday.

FENCEATHON 2011 FENCING EVENT
Waiver and Release of Liability

As a participant in FENCEATHON 2011 Friday, Oct. 21, 2011– Saturday, Oct. 22, 2011, I recognize and acknowledge that fencing can be a dangerous activity and that I will be engaging in activities that involve potential risk of minor or serious injury, including permanent disability, death, and/or economic losses which might result from my actions or inactions, the negligence of others, rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used.

As a condition to participating in this event, I agree to:

1. Wear proper equipment, and to be physically fit and sufficiently trained to participate in this event;
2. Review and abide by all safety rules;
3. Inspect my equipment prior to use, and if I believe anything to be unsafe, to advise fencing event officials and refuse to participate;
4. Give consent to receive any medical treatment the volunteer nurses or physicians deem necessary;
5. On behalf of myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, estate and assigns, I release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue or bring any form or kind of legal action against Chesapeake Fencing Club, Baltimore County Department of Recreation and Parks, Liberty Christian School, Liberty Church, PCA; Mercy Medical Center, the Sisters Academy of Baltimore, or any affiliated organizations, or their respective officers, directors, or employees, physicians or nurses, participants in the event, organizers and volunteers (collectively, "releasees"), from any and all claims, liability, demands, losses or damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise, including all claims arising out of my participation in this event and with respect to any claims related to medical care provided during the event.
6. If I am under 18 years of age, my parent or guardian will also sign below.
